Expectations and Responsibilities of Jana's Campaign Inc.

- Jana's Campaign will provide the *Safe Dates* curriculum and supporting materials free of charge to the school/teacher. (value \$225) – *if applicable*
- Jana's Campaign will provide, free of charge, a train-the-teacher in-service on the *Safe Dates* curriculum and program during your first year of implementation. – *if applicable*
- Jana's Campaign will make available mini-grants to support FACS projects and FCCLA chapter service projects that promote teen gender-violence prevention. These grants are awarded on a competitive basis.
- Jana's Campaign will provide teacher and Adviser support, including but not limited to, up-to-date information on teen gender violence, technical assistance, curricular and co-curricular materials, and access to resources and contacts that may help them to best utilize the program.
- When possible and appropriate, Jana's Campaign will promote your curricular and co-curricular programming as it relates to teen violence prevention. For example, showcasing your project on our website, newsletter, or an on-site venue.
- When possible and appropriate, Jana's Campaign will help your program in regional and state STAR events.
- Jana's Campaign will assist with your assessment activities as it relates to evaluating the *Love Doesn't Hurt* and *Safe Dates* programming.

Expectations and Responsibilities of the School and FACS/FCCLA Program

- The school will utilize the *Safe Dates* curriculum in the FACS classroom (*if applicable*).
- The FACS teacher/ FCCLA Adviser will attend and participate in a train-the-teacher in-service program on the *Safe Dates* curriculum and the *Love Doesn't Hurt* program. Jana's Campaign will provide some travel expense and teacher support (*if applicable*).
- The FACS teacher/ FCCLA Adviser will assist interested students in applying for Jana's Campaign mini-grants that support community service projects related to teen gender-violence prevention.
- The FACS teacher/ FCCLA Adviser will regularly update Jana's Campaign on curriculum/program progress.
- The FACS teacher / FCCLA Adviser will collect assessment data and share aggregate data with Jana's Campaign. (*if applicable*).
