Award Overview

Colorado Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) recognizes Competitive Events volunteers who exemplify a commitment to the continued success of STAR Events and the organization.

The mission of Family, Career and Community Leaders of America is to promote personal growth and leadership development through family and consumer sciences education. Focusing on the multiple roles of family member, wage earner, and community leader, members develop skills for life through: character development, creative and critical thinking, interpersonal communication, practical knowledge, and career preparation.

Philosophy of STAR Events

- To encourage and recognize active student participation and youth accomplishments.
- To develop members' knowledge, skills, and experience in various areas of leadership and career preparation through Family and Consumer Sciences education.
- To provide a positive and constructive format for teamwork and competition.
- To evaluate participants against a set of standard criteria rather than against another individual.
- To give members a safe environment to learn about responsibility by being involved in planning, conducting and evaluating the various levels of competition.
- To encourage respect and interaction between youth and adults to be fostered by establishing teams of adult and youth evaluators and event managers.
- To connect FCCLA and its membership to groups outside the traditional classroom environment.
- To promote the organization's belief that all people are winners.

Evaluative Criteria

Evidence Materials Nominees will be recognized for their service to Colorado Family, Career and Community Leaders of America, in one or more of the areas listed below. Colorado FCCLA will award two awards – one FCCLA Volunteer and one Business & Industry Volunteer. Evaluation will be based on the following:

- A. STAR Events involvement and leadership roles assumed at the local, district, and state levels. (40 points)
- B. Resources developed to help teachers and prospective teachers make STAR Events an integral part of Family and Consumer Sciences education (e.g. workshops, lesson plans, etc.). (25 points)
- C. Impact of volunteer activities on FCCLA and STAR Events overall. (25 points)
- D. Reflection of the FCCLA mission and philosophy of STAR Events in personal life. (10 points)
