

# DRESS CODE

In order to maintain the positive image of our organization, the following dress code is in effect for members while attending State Leadership Conference:

- General Sessions/Workshops– Business Professional or Business Casual
- Competitive Events – Business Professional; only exception-costumes if event allows
- Ultimate Fun Night – Casual Attire
- Casual Attire is acceptable after 9 p.m. on Wednesday and after 8 p.m. Thursday evening.

***Members not in proper dress code will be not be admitted to conference sessions.***

## **Business Professional Attire**

No clothing should be torn, skin tight, or revealing.

Suit or blazer, slacks or dockers-type pants, dresses, skirts that are no less than 2 inches above the knee, dress slacks, oxford shirts, blouses, sweaters, and dress shoes. Dark leggings (brown, black, or navy) may be worn with an appropriate top that hits mid thigh.

## **Business Casual Attire**

No clothing should be torn, skin tight, or revealing. No plastic-type flip flops or beach shoes.

Dress or casual slacks (no blue jeans), cropped pants, sleeveless or short-sleeved dresses (no spaghetti straps or strapless); skirts that are no less than 2 inches above the knee; blouses or collared, oxford or polo shirt, and dress shoes or sandals. Dress or shirt straps must be no less than 3-fingers wide. Dark leggings (brown, black, or navy) may be worn with an appropriate top that hits mid thigh.

## **Casual Attire**

No clothing should be torn, skin tight, or revealing. Includes blue jeans (not frayed or torn) and the conference t-shirt, FCCLA t-shirt, or school spirit t-shirt. Clothing that is frayed or torn or has objectionable or suggestive messages or pictures is not allowed at any time. Pajama attire, sweats, halter-tops, spaghetti straps, skin tight clothing, skirts that are more than 2 inches above the knee, and bared midriffs are NOT acceptable at any time.
